The purpose of this statement is to set out how Archbishop Sentamu Academy will use its 16 to 19 tuition fund allocation to support students who have been academically disadvantaged due to coronavirus (COVID-19).

How Archbishop Sentamu Academy will use the 16 to 19 tuition fund

The 16 to 19 tuition fund will be used to provide small group tuition for students aged 16 to 19 who have not yet achieved a grade 4 or above in English and/or maths.

Students with Special Educational Needs and Disabilities (SEND) and those for whom English is an additional language (EAL) will also be supported by this provision.

Students with an Educational Health Care Plan (EHCP) will also be supported by this provision.

Allocation of support

We allocated support to *all* students who met the criteria of not having achieved at least a grade 4 in English and/or maths on an equal basis.

We then applied additional support above this to SEND/EHCP students and EAL students.

Tuition groups will comprise no more than four students and the tuition sessions will be scheduled in addition to the planned programme of study hours already timetabled for the academic year 2020/21.

Tuition and additional support will be delivered by two Graduate Tutors, who will focus their support on GCSE maths and/or English exam re-sit preparation for the Summer 2021 series, based on personalised targets set by the class teachers.

Our commitment

Archbishop Sentamu Academy is committed to ensuring the tuition fund is used in accordance with the Government's guidance on the 16 to 19 tuition fund by:

- producing this statement setting out how the fund will be used to support the most disadvantaged students
- publishing this guidance on the Archbishop Sentamu Academy website
- recording the use of the fund, including references to individual students who receive support, the needs of those students, the number of hours of tuition delivered and retain the evidence of the tuition provided
- deliver the extra tuition and spend the allocated funds in the academic year 2020/21
- notify the Education Skills Funding Agency (ESFA) of any underspend from the Fund for it to be reclaimed
