



Dear Parent/Carer

Firstly I would like to take this opportunity to thank all of you for ensuring children continue to carry out Lateral Flow Testing twice weekly as this helps protect our community. All students will be regularly provided with Lateral Flow test kits to be used at home throughout this term. Here is the [link](#) to record the results. Should your child test positive then please contact the Academy, self-isolate your child and book a PCR test for confirmation.

Sadly there are still high rates of COVID across the country and across Hull, meaning many children are having to self-isolate following a positive result. I would like to reassure you that if your child does have to self-isolate the Academy will continue to provide work for your child to complete. It is important that your child completes this so they do not fall behind with their studies. The rest of this letter outlines how work can be accessed from home.

Your child will have been added to a Google Classroom for every lesson on their timetable. Students have now all been given their account details for this. Students will have been shown how to access their Google Classrooms by their tutor or in their ICT lesson.

As a minimum each class teacher will upload work to the Google Classroom at the latest by the end of the day that a lesson appears on your child's timetable. Once the work has been completed students must submit it online to their teacher or their teacher will not know it has been completed.

Some teachers may deliver their lesson in the Academy and set up a Google Meet so absent students can join. Please note: this is only where it is practical to do so. These lessons will be live at the time they are timetabled and can be accessed through their Google Calendar. If there are no events in the Google Calendar then there are no live lessons and they should look for work in the Google Classroom at the end of the day. If you have given consent for your child to join Google Meet previously either through an online form or through the planner then you do not need to do so again. Without consent teachers cannot invite students to the Google Meets so if you still need to give consent please contact the relevant Progress Leader below.

If you experience any problems with online working, for example any of the following, please contact the relevant Progress leader:

- Forgotten or not received their log in details,
- Not been added to a classroom for a lesson they have,
- Work has not been set for a lesson
- Do not have access to the Internet or a suitable device to complete the work on please
