We are really looking forward to welcoming your child into our Academy community for their Transition Week on Monday 11th July to Friday 15th July 2022.

Equipment

Students need to wear their current Primary School uniform and bring a P.E Kit with them each day.

All students will be able to receive free hot meals or sandwiches from the canteen throughout the week. They are also welcome to bring their own packed lunch or use their biometric account, which will be set up at the beginning of the week. Students also need to bring a schoolbag, and at least a pen, pencil and ruler.

We will be providing all students with a planner sheet for the week which will have their timetable on it. They will also be able to use this to collect reward stamps each day. These rewards will be celebrated at the end of the week in a Celebration Assembly where certificates will be awarded. We have a limited number of spaces for parents to attend this celebration assembly, please email the Hello account above if you would like to attend.

Arrangements for the Week

Students should arrive through the entrance on Bilton Grove.

(When looking at the Main Reception from Preston Road, you head right towards Purple House and then turn left along Bilton Grove. The entrance is a little way along the road on the left side.)

Staff will be on duty to meet students from 8am when students are able to come in for Breakfast Club. Students must arrive to school by 8.35am at the latest.

Throughout the week, students will be taken through our expectations and will experience the normal routine of interesting and exciting lessons across a broad range of subjects. There will be older students ready to help in lessons, and TA support if your child normally has this in lessons and this has been discussed with the academy SEND team.

Students will also be sitting some Cognitive Ability Tests during the week so that staff are able to tailor their curriculum ready for September.

Since students are preparing for life in secondary school, we will be escorting students back to Bilton Grove at 3pm to walk/cycle home themselves or get picked up. If you have any specific concerns about your child getting home please do let us know. Staff will be on hand to answer any questions you may have.

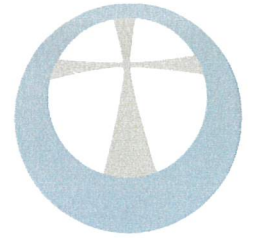
