If a child discloses a safeguarding issue to you, you should:

- Listen, believe, allow them to talk freely and do not ask leading questions
 - Stay calm, do not show that you are shocked or upset
 - Tell them they have done the right thing in telling you.
 - Do not tell them they should have told you sooner
 - Explain that you will have to pass this information on to the Safeguarding Lead. Do not promise to keep it a secret.
 - Write up the facts as soon as possible in the child's own words.
 - Sign and date and pass it on to one of the named people above.
- Alternatively, if appropriate, make a referral to children's social care and/or the police directly, and tell the DSL as soon as possible that you have done so.



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If a child is, or is likely to, suffer significant harm, then **call 999**
Submit a concern to local authority children's social care here:

If you have concerns or there is an allegation about a member of staff (including supply or a volunteer) speak to the Principal.

If the concern is about the Principal, speak to the chair of governors.

Evacuations:

An alarm will sound. Please follow the exit signs (green with white arrow and person) which directs you to the nearest external door. Do not go back into the academy for any reason. Assemble where instructed and a member of staff will register you.

First Aid:

Please speak to any member of staff with a radio, if you are near a phone call ext 2028 to request first aid.
