Featured Story - ASA's Got Talent!

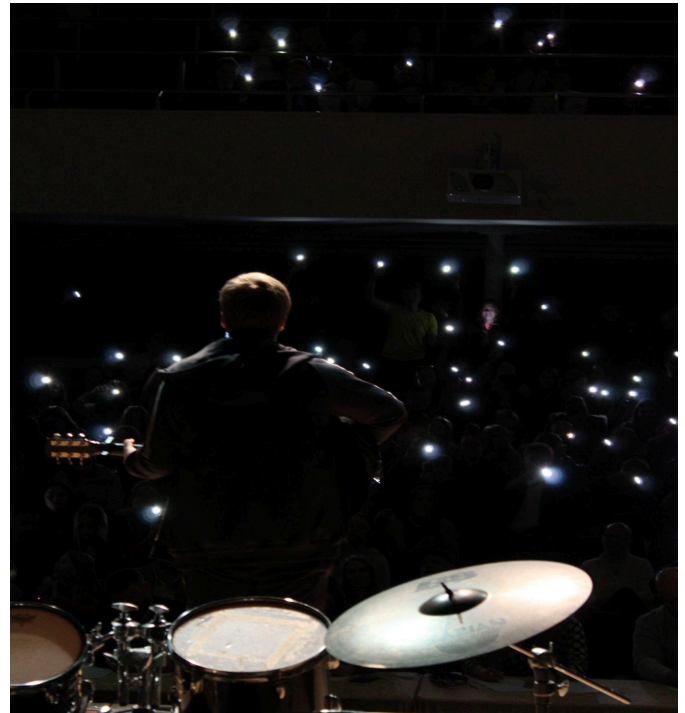
On Thursday 21st March, ASA hosted the incredible talent show: **ASA's Got Talent!**

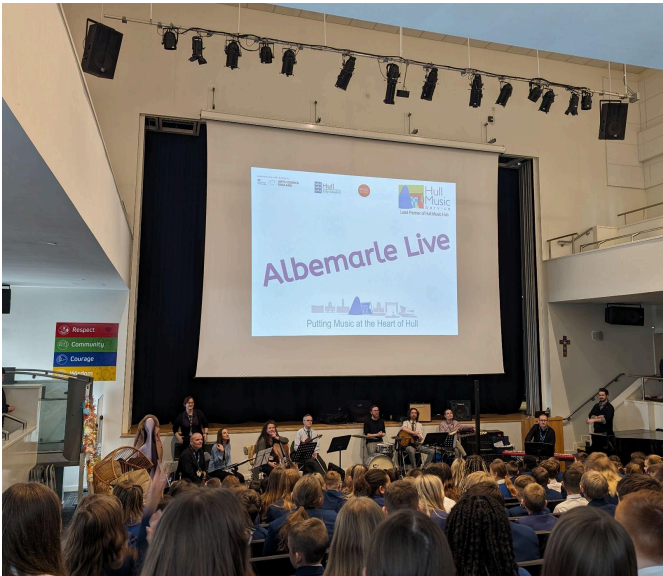
