You will be completing a one lesson assessment which will give you the chance to show us how well you read and write, while explaining your understanding of English!

## Some things to remember for your assessment:

- -Read the text carefully. All of the questions refer to some part of the text itself (normally, the section you are directed to read.)
- -When the question says *refer to the text* or *use evidence from the text* you must refer to some part of the text or use it in a quotation form (e.g) I get the impression that the bear was powerful because it had 'claws longer than forks'
- -When a question asks you to *explain your ideas*, explain what you think about something!
- -Think about word classes (such as nouns, concrete nouns adverbs, verbs, abstract nouns)



Finally, if you are asked to write a short story then think about the beginning, middle and end. If you are asked to write a nonfiction piece, think about tone, audience and consider the Purpose and the form. At the end, check your work when your teacher has said 'you have 5 minutes remaining'
