

You will be completing a one lesson assessment which will give you the chance to show us how well you read and explain your understanding of English!

Some things to remember for your assessment:

-Read the text carefully. All of the questions refer to some part of the text itself (normally, the section you are directed to read.)

-When the question says *refer to the text* or *use evidence from the text* you must refer to some part of the text or use it in a quotation form (e.g) I get the impression that the bear was powerful because it had 'claws longer than forks'

-When a question asks you to *explain your ideas*, explain what you think about something!

-Think about word classes (such as nouns, concrete nouns adverbs, verbs, abstract nouns)



Finally, if you are asked to write a short story then think about the beginning, middle and end. You should also use no more than 2 characters, a selection of devices (such as similes, metaphors, alliteration and personification) and choose your words wisely. At the end, check your work when your teacher has said 'you have 5 minutes remaining'
