### ChatHealth for Young People:

Did you know that your 11-19 year olds can now send a text message to the 0-19 Health Visitor and School Nursing Team?

They can message for age-appropriate advice and support. To start a chat with the 0-19 Team, they just send a message to [07312 263199](tel:07312263199).

When they send a message, they will get a reply. A member of the team will text back between 9am-4.30pm Monday to Friday (not at weekends or bank holidays).
