PSHE:

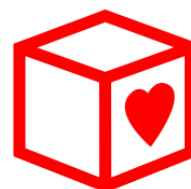

Careers

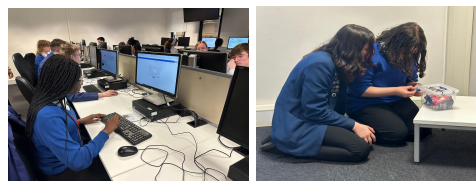
