

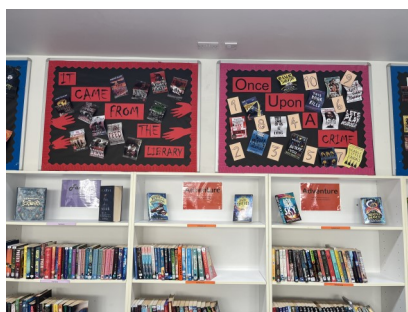

Summer is on the horizon, and it's bringing amazing books with it.

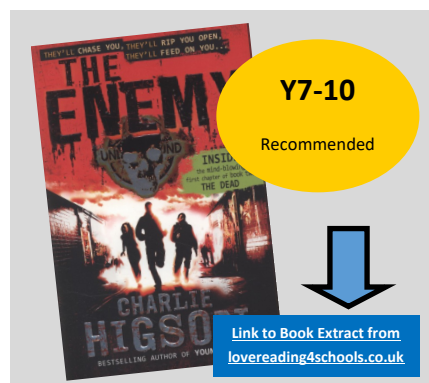
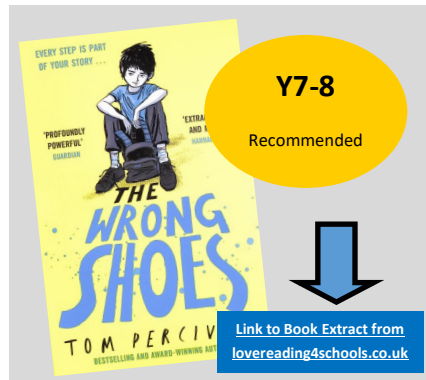
