FREE SCHOOL MEALS

If any of the below apply to you and you have not yet applied for Free Schools Meals, please use the link at the bottom to complete an application. You must be in receipt of one of the following benefits:

- income support
- income based jobseeker's allowance
- income related employment and support allowance (ESA IR)
- universal credit if the household is earning less than £7,400 per year
- asylum seekers receiving support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- the guaranteed element of state pension credit
- child tax credit with an annual income of no more than £16,190 as assessed by the Inland Revenue. If also in receipt of working tax credit you will not be eligible
- working tax credit run on paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for working tax credit

CONTACTING THE ACADEMY

The main port of call is always reception, who will then transfer you to the correct staff member.

Tutors will always be the first point of contact for day to day occurrences, for example: uniform, equipment, homework and other general enquiries.
